

NWCFC Funding for Operation and Maintenance Conversation:

Washington Recreation and Conservation Organization (RCO).

- 1. Community Forest Program
 - a. Both acquisition and ongoing maintenance funding, application window available in March of 2024.
- 2. Salmon Recovery Fund
 - Can carryover funding to stewardship planning as needed.
- 3. No Child Left Inside
 - Two Year funding program
- 4. Family Forest Fish Passage Program
 - Aimed at small landowners to help fix artificial in-stream fish barriers.
- 5. **NOVA-Trails**
 - Aimed at Nonhighway and Off-Road Vehicle Activities, Hiking, Skiing, Biking, ATVing
- 6. WWRP
 - Riparian Enhancement Projects.

Weyerhaeuser Family Forest Foundation – Sustainable Forest and Communities Initiative.

- Flexible funding from WFF.
- 3 yr funding cycles
- Funded Community Forest work initially

<u>National Parks Service – Rivers Trails and Conservation Assistance Program</u>: Planning Assistance Program for community led conservation projects. Application window in March of each year.

Washington: Department of Ecology

- Support Riparian management/ watershed protection
- Shovel ready projects prioritized.
- 319 Point Source
- Streamflow

Oregon: Department of Environmental Quality/ OWEB

- Support Source Water Protection
- 319 Point Source Protection

Forest Management Funding: WA DNR, Wildfire risk reduction. DNR Forest Resiliency Program (All Land Grant Program) mainly East Side.

- Cost share with private landowners, Chelan CO able to provide funding and resources.

NRCS – EQUIP, funding likely going to agriculture.

- Tribal nexus for projects would be likely more prioritize.

<u>Oregon Conservation and Recreation Fund</u> (Oregon): Small Scale Projects Available for funding through the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife.

Oregon Access & Habitat (ODFW)

Property monitoring via State Police or ODFW Staff.

<u>Private Forest Accord Mitigation Fund</u>, fish passage \$12 million a year. RFP Out for fall, money in Q1 of 2024. Currently still in the decision making process, Chad Washington is a member of the planning committee.
